I. Postsecondary level

Postsecondary:

- Postsecondary as defined by Merriam-Webster: "of, relating to, or being education following secondary school"
- Federal regulation: a postsecondary institution is defined as "an institution that provides education to students beyond the secondary school level; secondary school level means the educational level (not beyond grade 12) at which secondary education is provided as determined under State law."¹
- Benchmarking methodology

1. Cornell Law School "Electronic Code of Federal Regulations"



Higher Education Act of 1965

SEC. 101. [20 U.S.C. 1001] GENERAL DEFINITION OF INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

(a) INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.—For purposes of this Act, other than title IV, the term "institution of higher education" means an educational institution in any State that—

(1) admits as regular students only persons having a certificate of graduation from a school providing secondary education, or the recognized equivalent of such a certificate, or persons who meet the requirements of section 484(d);

(2) is legally authorized within such State to provide a program of education beyond secondary education;

(3) provides an educational program for which the institution awards a bachelor's degree or provides not less than a 2year program that is acceptable for full credit toward such a degree, or awards a degree that is acceptable for admission to a graduate or professional degree program, subject to review and approval by the Secretary;

(4) is a public or other nonprofit institution; and


(5) is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association, or if not so accredited, is an institution that has been granted preaccreditation status by such an agency or association that has been recognized by the Secretary for the granting of preaccreditation status, and the Secretary has determined that there is satisfactory assurance that the institution will meet the accreditation standards of such an agency or association within a reasonable time.

2. Determining the Program Level Represented on U.S. Credentials: Benchmarking

Methods for Evaluating Credentials

There are two methods for determining the level of credential: **year counting** and **benchmarking.**



When year counting, the years of education

represented by the credential are matched against what those years would represent in the United States. For example, a *Baccalauréat* from France is awarded after completion of 12 years of primary and secondary school. In the United States, 12 years of primary and secondary represents completion of high school. Therefore, followers of the year counting methodology would consider a *Baccalauréat* comparable to a U.S. high school diploma

Benchmarking, on the other hand, involves reviewing the entrance requirements of the credential as well as what the credential can lead to in the home country, such as employment or further education. Benchmarks are important concepts for establishing basic levels of education across and within educational systems. Benchmarks represent assumptions about minimum standards for completion of a level of study.

The level at which an academic program is offered determines the anterior requirements for admission, the access afforded its graduates determines its purpose; both of these factors influence the program's content. You can more easily determine the content of a course taken by a student if you also know the level of the credential rather than solely by a detailed assessment of the syllabus. Most evaluators use a combination of year counting and benchmarking.

U.S. Associate's Degree

- Merriam-Webster: "a degree that is given to a student who has completed two years of study at a junior college, college, or university in the U.S."
- Although rare, some associate's degree programs might be three years full-time.
 - This does not change the fact that an associate's degree is the specific credential awarded!
- <u>Not</u> considered a benchmark credential in the United States.
- Can act as a terminal credential.
- Typically for employment purposes or pursuing further higher education.



Is an associate's degree always two years?

- Although two years is the most common length, there are some outlier programs that may exceed this.
- Most associate's degrees require a minimum of 60 credits.
 - Except, for example, Portland Community College and their <u>Paralegal AAS program</u>, with 90 credits.

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U.S. Bachelor's Degree

- Merriam-Webster: "a degree that is given to a student by a college or university usually after four years of study."
- If the standard length for a U.S. bachelor's degree is four years, then what does that mean for three-year degrees?
- The minimum required total of credits for a four-year bachelor's degree is typically 120.
- Completion of a bachelor's degree in the US can grant access to graduate education.



Could a bachelor's degree be three years in length?

- Some schools claim to offer short programs.
 - A phrase often seen in advertisements: "Earn a bachelor's degree in as little as three years" – but is this true?
- It depends on the total number of credits awarded.
- "Comparable to a bachelor's degree" vs. "completion of undergraduate coursework toward a bachelor's degree"



II. Common Cases



Indian Nursing Diplomas



- Typically awarded by state nursing boards/councils or the state directorate of medical education
 - Final marks sheets from just the school would not be sufficient
- Admission requirement tends to be completion of Standard XII (Senior Secondary Certificate or equivalent)
 - Always good to check because there exist nursing programs that require Standard X (Secondary Certificate) and only grant access to the first year of a BSc. in Nursing program.
- HEIs in India offer a "Post-Basic" Bachelor of Science degree program in Nursing for those who completed the three-year Nursing Diploma.

Certificates and diplomas

Undergraduate certificate and diploma courses (or "graduate certificates or diplomas" in traditional Indian terminology) are available in a wide range of specialized or vocational fields such as engineering and technology, teacher education, nursing, pharmacy, foreign languages, fine arts, hotel management and business. The programs vary in length from six months to three years. Entry is normally based on the completion of either secondary school (Class 10) or higher secondary school (Class 12).

Certificate and diploma programs are provided not only by universities and university affiliated colleges, but also by other institutions. For example, three-year diplomas in a range of engineering and technological fields, with entry usually based on the completion of secondary school, are available at polytechnics. Certificate and diploma courses in nursing and midwifery are mostly offered at institutions attached to hospitals.

Depending on the field of study, certificate or diploma holders may be admitted into a bachelor's degree program with advanced standing. For example, an individual who holds a three-year polytechnic diploma in engineering and technology may be allowed lateral entry into the second year or third semester of a bachelor's degree program in the same field.

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Associate's or Incomplete Bachelor's?

Could be interpreted as being equivalent to an Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing plus one year of additional undergraduate coursework in nursing.

Or....

Could be interpreted as being equivalent to completion of three years of undergraduate coursework toward a bachelor's degree.



Tips and Tricks


- Always check the admission requirements—is Standard X or XII required for entry?
- If facing a post-Std. X nursing program, differentiate secondary units from undergraduate credits(like an engineering diploma)
- Consider the purpose for evaluating a nursing diploma.
 - Admissions into a bachelor's degree program? Applying for licensure?
- Check with your institution for equivalency recommendations.



Chinese zhuanke Programs



- Offered by both universities and colleges at the state or national level
- Programs are typically 3 years. There are also 2 and 2.5-year programs.
- *Zhuanke* is <u>not</u> a **degree**, but can be treated like one
- There exist "Top-up" programs for *zhuanke* graduates who enter a *benke* program with advanced standing.
- <u>TAICEP 2019 webinar</u> indicates that *zhuanke* diplomas only grant access to the 3rd and 4th year of a *benke*.
 - Consensus of attendees at this webinar: it is <u>not</u> recommended to admit those with a *zhuanke* into graduate programs.
 - Attendees also consider the zhuanke to be equivalent to an associates, but they do not consider it the same thing as one.
- Upon graduation, students are awarded a Graduation Certificate (毕业 证书) and a corresponding transcript.



Associate or Incomplete Bachelor's?

- It depends entirely on the field of study. If there exists an associate's degree in the same field in the US, then equivalent to an associates.
- Otherwise, treated as an incomplete bachelor's degree
- Not uncommon to see these paired with a top-up bachelor's degree for graduate admission
 - In these situations, do you treat three years of undergraduate coursework in a zhuanke as being equivalent to two years of credit? Or award three years of credit and then the total for their top-up (typically two years)?




Francophone Diplôme Nationale/Licence Professionnelle

History and Context

- France and former colonial states follow a similar system, based on legislation.
- Terminology tends to be very specific to legal standings.
- Schools in France can award a *Diplôme Nationale*, which may vary in length (Bac + 3, 4, or 5).
- The Professional Licentiate (*Licence Professionnelle-Licence Pro*) is newer in France and tends to be geared more toward vocational endeavors.
- Individual countries may have specific provisions in place for their credentials, but they may also follow the specifics of the French system, such as grading.





Tips and Tricks

- First things first: if the school is private, make sure that the individual program is accredited!
 - Especially the case in Benin and Senegal
- Become familiar with the individual country's education ladder and how it compares with France's system.
- If necessary, check legislation from the Government of France (When in doubt, trust <u>ONISEP</u>!) and/or the government of the country of origin.



Non-honors degrees from Australia, New Zealand, and South Africa



Associate's or Bachelor's?

- Based on the National Qualifications Frameworks (NQFs) of these countries, it seems that the levels of these degrees prevents them from being equivalent to an associate's degree.
- Non-honors bachelor's degrees are designed to gain access to honors programs, which tend to be only one year. Honors degrees can then grant access to graduate education.



The AQF has 10 levels, each with defined criteria based on a taxonomy of learning outcomes. Higher education qualifications are placed between level 5 (the Diploma) and level 10 (the Doctoral Degree). The Bachelor Degree is at level 7.Each AQF qualification has a set of descriptors which define the type and complexity of knowledge, skills and application of the knowledge and skills that a graduate who has been awarded that qualification has attained, and the typical volume of learning associated with that qualification type. Bachelor's "Pass" degree at AQF level 7

*NOT equivalent to a US bachelor's degree, despite being 4.5-5 years in length.

Associate's or incomplete bachelor's

- Tend to be equivalent to incomplete bachelor's
- Not considered equivalent to associate's degree since they lead into honors degrees, which are a minimum of one year
- In these countries, there exist Diplomas at a lower NQF level that are more closely resemble US associate's programs.



Tips and Tricks

- Always pay attention to the honors or non-honors status!
- If unsure, check a country's national qualifications framework website for more information
- It is recommended to consider the NQF levels more so than year counting.





Caribbean Community (CARICOM)

- Credentials below the bachelor's degree level awarded by the Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC)-unless issued by a country's MOE or a similar government organization
- Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE) = General Certificate of Education – Advanced Levels (Alevels)
- CXC issues the Associate's degree, indicating completion of two years of postsecondary ed following the CAPE.
- Total postsecondary years: 3 (1 + 2).
 - Or, if strict year-counting, it's two years of CAPE and two years of the associate's—4 years.





The Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC) is awarding Associate Degrees based on performance at Grades I to V in clusters of ten Units for the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE). The clusters provide coherent programs of study, typically of two years' duration. Candidates, however, have up to five years to complete certification in the Units required to earn the Associate Degree

Associate's or Incomplete Bachelor's?

- Regardless of total postsecondary years completed, a CXC associate's program would only grant access to upper division coursework in a bachelor's degree program at universities in the CARICOM region.
- A common field for this program is General Studies, which exists in the US as well
- Most fields offered for the CXC associates are also offered in the US.

Ukrainian Junior Specialist/Bachelor

- Based on the Soviet Union professional secondary diploma.
- Awarded by technical schools/colleges (teknikum/uchilishte).
- Served as a replacement to the Diploma of Professional Secondary Education.
- Last Junior Specialist was awarded in 2016, following the discontinuation of this credential in Ukraine.
 - Schools are now beginning to issue the Junior Bachelor diploma.
- Junior Specialist programs grant access to upper division in a bachelor or specialist degree program.
- Most programs are 2 years, but 3-year programs do exist despite their rarity.



Vatican Baccalaureatus & Licentia

- Baccalaureatus in Diritto Canonico, Baccalaureatus in Filosofia, Baccalaureatus in Scienze Religiose are all three years.
 - Typically, equivalent to three years of undergraduate coursework, comparable to a bachelor's degree
- Baccalaureatus in Teologia is five years.
 - Typically, equivalent to a US bachelor's degree
- Licentia is actually the second-cycle (master's level) degree...
- ...while the *Magistero* is a four-year degree, considered equivalent to a US bachelor's degree.
